

What is NYLT?

- National Youth Leadership Training is an exciting, action-packed program designed for councils to provide youth members with leadership skills and experience they can use in their home troops and in other situations demanding leadership of self and others.
- The NYLT course centers around the concepts of what a leader must BE, what he must KNOW, and what he must DO. The key elements are then taught with a clear focus on HOW TO. The skills come alive during the week as the patrol goes on a Quest for the Meaning of Leadership.
- NYLT is a six-day course. Content is delivered in a troop and patrol outdoor setting with an emphasis on immediate application of learning in a fun environment. Interconnecting concepts and work processes are introduced early, built upon, and aided by the use of memory aids, which allows participants to understand and employ the leadership skills much faster.
- Through activities, presentations, challenges, discussions, and audio-visual support, NYLT participants will be engaged in a unified approach to leadership that will give them the skill and confidence to lead well. Through a wide range of activities, games, and adventures, participants will work and play together as they put into action the best Scouting has to offer.

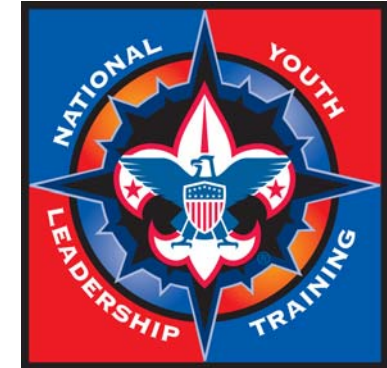

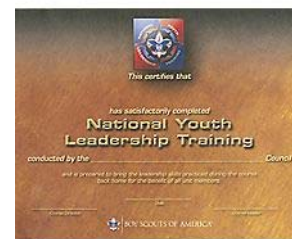
The primary goal of NYLT is to develop Scouts as leaders. To be a good leader requires the knowledge and the ability to use the right tools. At NYLT, we teach the Scouts the skills necessary to manage group dynamics and performance. These are the same skills taught at Fortune 500 companies. Recognition:

Upon completion of the NYLT course, the participant will be presented with a certificate, patch, and a special Yocona Area Council National Youth Leadership Training gift at the graduation ceremony.



All participants must have a current Annual Health Medical Record parts A, B, & C.

Boy Scout Requirements:

- Be currently registered as a member of the Boy Scouts of America.
- Be First Class rank or higher.
- Be the minimum age of 13 years old.
- Have completed the seventh grade.
- Be a current or prospective youth leader recommended by his Scoutmaster.

Venturing Scout Requirements:

- Be currently registered as a member of a Venturing Crew.
- Be the minimum age of 14 years old and no older than 20 years old.
- Be a current or prospective youth leader recommended by his or her Crew Advisor.

A **\$50.00** deposit is required with each application submitted.

The full fee for the course is **\$300** which includes food, camping fees, program materials, participant cap, t-shirt, training neckerchief, and NYLT recognition items. The fee must be paid by **May 31, 2018**. A **\$10 discount** will be applied if the participant's home unit (Troop/Crew/Post) attends Summer Camp at Camp Yocona in 2018.

The Early Bird Special

If you pay your full fee before **March 31, 2018**, you will only have to pay **\$275**. That is a savings of **\$25**.



The **\$50.00** deposit is non-refundable. The remaining fees are fully refundable (minus the deposit) only up to May 31, 2018. After this date, the fee is **ONLY** transferrable. *Please contact the Scout Office to check on the availability of Camperships.*

It is our hope to have all youth leaders trained in NYLT Leadership principles. With this goal in mind, we can be assured we are delivering the promise of preparing our youth to be our leaders of tomorrow.
